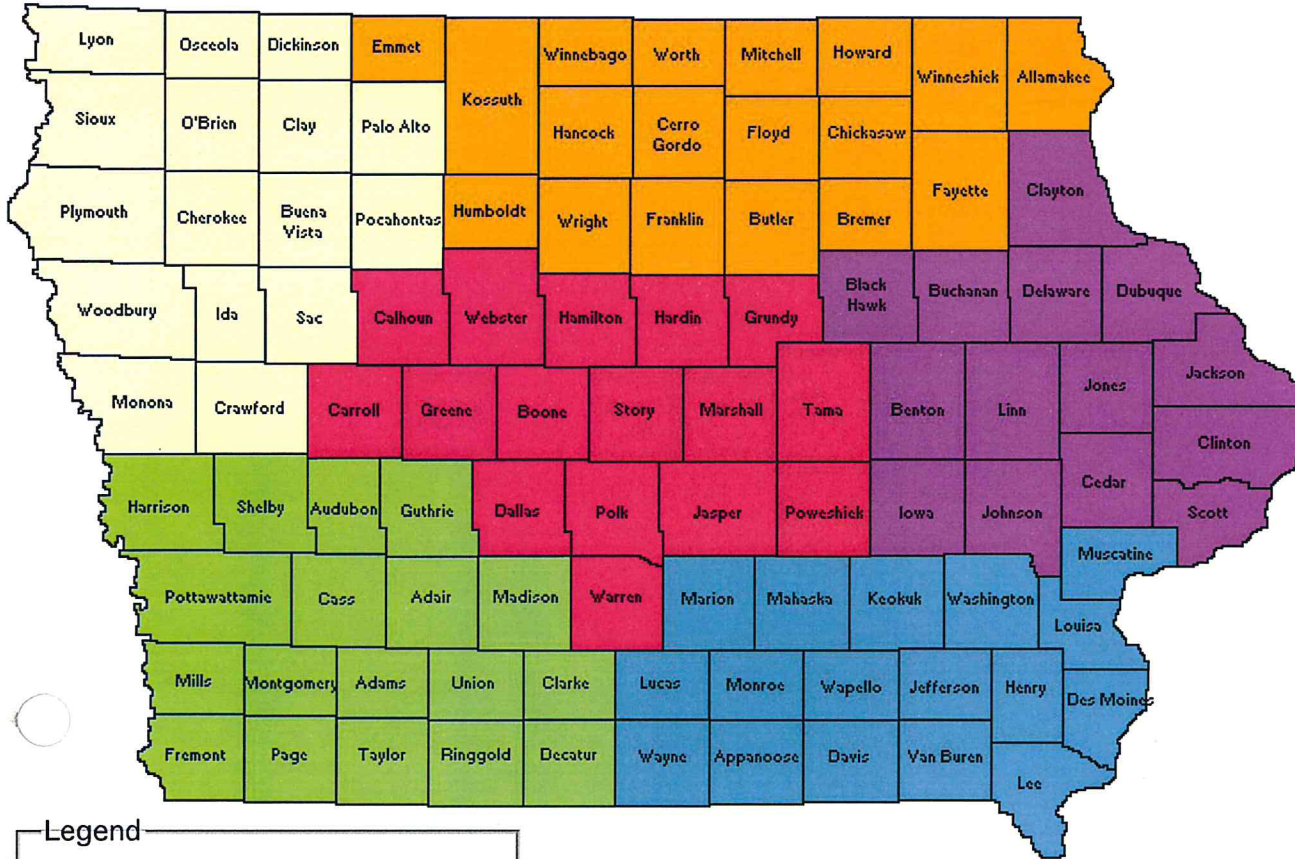

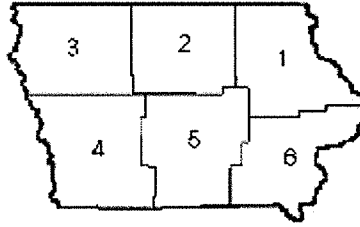

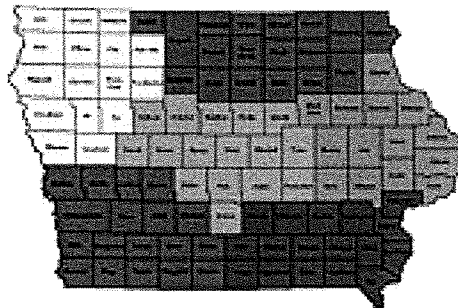

Introduction and Directions

The Iowa Environmental Health Association Registration program is for all active environmental health practitioners in Iowa.

Individuals with a RS/REHS or CEHT will be added to the registry following the submission of the required paperwork (proof of RS/REHS status). Those with an RS/REHS do not need to turn in evidence of continuing education, but must provide evidence that their registration is current to retain membership.

Registry members agree to complete 12 hours of continuing education over the next calendar year.
